DISCUSSION ABOUT SENIOR NORDIC CHAMPIONSHIPS 2020

Nordic Championships: In person or Online?

It was discussed and then decided that Nordic Championships will be held Online. The rules of the Championships must be reviewed in order to decide if the competition can be called Nordic Championships, or Nordic Online Cup.

Each MF will gather their athletes to one city in their country for the competition.

Organizer

Since the Championships will be held Online, Norway will take over as the organizer. They will have a team of 5-6 persons working on the Online technical aspects.

Funding

NTF will contact IWF to ask for the 2020 IWF Development Funds (8 000 USD?) to be used for the two Nordic Championships. Norway will make calculations on travel and hotel expenses ASAP for the Online Team officials.

If the IWF Development Funds cannot be used, NTF and the MFs will help in funding the expenses of the Online Team for both Championships. Estimate on travel of 5-6 persons to Larvik, NOR, is 25 000 – 30 000 NOK per competition.

Norway was asked to send a written estimate of the expenses to NTF President ASAP.

Fri 27/11 set-up of Competition and Online system. At 17.00 (NOR) run-through of the competition system, each MF must have their set-up ready for testing. Some athletes will lift.

Technical requirements for System

At the competition place one needs PC screens and 1-3 high quality cameras.

Technical meeting

Tryggve Duun (NOR) will invite MF President and one person who can be in charge of the technique at the competition. The meeting will take place very soon.

At the meeting the Nordic Championship Invitation will be adjusted to the new time table and technical requirements of the Online competition.

Records and Anti-Doping

MFs shall inform their National Anti-Doping Organizations about the competition. Athletes who are registered in Adams and follow WADA / IWF Anti-doping Rules can make Nordic Records in the competition. If an athlete who is not registered in Adams makes a Nordic Record, s/he must be tested within 24 hours.

Medals

Athletes will receive medals after the competition, it takes about a week to have the medals engraved. NTF will send the medals to the MF office.
